

Romantic Revolution

The four famous notes that comprise Beethoven's "fate" motif pave the way into a robust new era of music with a *Romantic Revolution*. Leading to those famous sounds, this program takes us from the rhythmic groove of Daniel Nelson's *Steampunk Blizzard*, to the seductive sounds of Bruch's *First Violin Concerto*, to the dark and penetrative opening gestures of Beethoven's *Egmont Overture*, all leading to Beethoven's iconic *Fifth Symphony*, the most famous piece across the musical spectrum.

Modeste Mussorgsky's *Pictures at an Exhibition* was written as a homage to his friend, artist Victor Hartmann. It takes the listener through a "musical gallery" of vibrant orchestral color and dramatically shifting moods. Mussorgsky's masterpiece encompasses breathtaking emotions and, in Maurice Ravel's imaginative orchestration, is the Russian genius' most beloved and revered symphonic opus. Also featured on the program is Juneau Symphony's brilliant concertmaster, Franz Felkl, performing Beethoven's monumental *Violin Concerto*. The work's purity and tactful simplicity has placed it among the most revered and adored concerti ever written.
